### What donations supported last year:

- In Malawi, new clean water sources were provided to 61,500 people
- In The Gambia, 78.4 tonnes of local produce was sold to tourist hotels and restaurants returning over £25,152 of income to local Gambian farmers.
- In Mozambique, 6,800 orphans and vulnerable children were supported with school material, clothing and registration.
